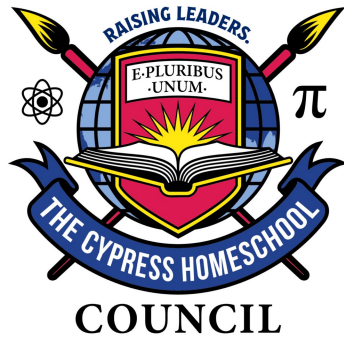

Wed, Sep 2, 2026	1:00 p.m.	Art Through the Ages	From petroglyphs to photography – discover how humans have expressed themselves and how art shapes how we view history.
Tue, Oct 13, 2026	1:00 p.m.	Australian Wildlife	It's got flying foxes, the only two egg-laying mammals in the world, and more!
Wed, Dec 2, 2026	1:00 p.m.	Russia: Royalty and Revolt	Learn about the dramatic fall of the Russian Royals and the rise of Democracy in Russia.
Tue, Jan 5, 2027	1:00 p.m.	Down in the Dermis	Take a closer look at the integumentary system in this lab as you learn about the structures of the epidermis. Get an up-close view of the different features on skin that some animals have developed to survive in their natural environments.
